Daniel in the Lions' Den - Daniel 6

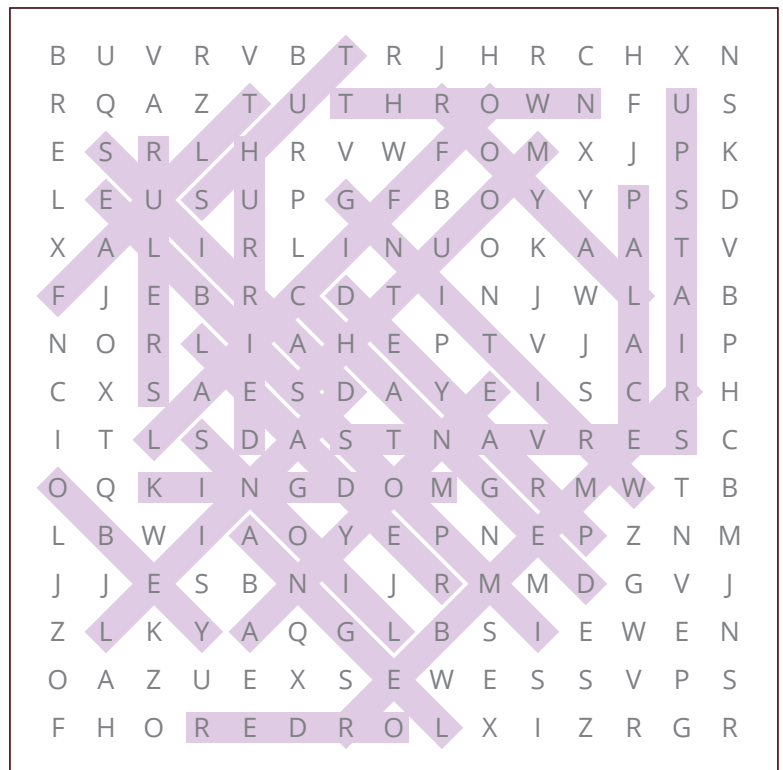
Solution
