Solution

The **soldiers** made fun of **Jesus**. They took off his clothes and put a **purple robe** on him. They twisted **thorns** together to make a **crown** and placed it on Jesus' head. They fell on their knees and pretended to honor Jesus. Then they led him away to nail him to a **cross**.

A man named Simon was passing by. The soldiers forced him to **carry** the cross. They brought Jesus to the place called **Golgotha**. The word Golgotha means the Place of the Skull.

There the soldiers **nailed** Jesus to the cross. Two **criminals** were **crucified** next to Jesus, one on his right and the other on his left. Jesus said, "**Father, forgive** them. They don't know what they are doing."

Above his head they placed a **sign**. It read, "This is Jesus, the **King** of the **Jews**."

Darkness covered the whole land for three hours. Then Jesus cried out in a loud **voice**. He said, "My **God**, my God, why have you **deserted** me?"

Jesus said, "It is **finished**." Then he **bowed** his **head** and **died**.
