Solution

It was the **day before** the **Sabbath**. **Jesus** had **died** on the **cross**. As **evening** approached, a rich man named **Joseph**, who was a **follower** of Jesus, went to **Pilate**. He asked for Jesus' body. So Pilate gave the **body** to Joseph.

Joseph took the body and **wrapped** it in a clean **linen cloth**. He placed it in his own **new tomb** that he had cut out of the rock. He **rolled** a **big stone** in front of the **entrance** to the tomb. Then he went away.

Mary Magdalene and Mary the mother of Joseph **saw** where Jesus' body had been placed.

The **chief priests** and the **Pharisees** went to Pilate. They told Pilate to put a **guard** outside the tomb. "Take some guards with you," Pilate answered. "Go. Make the tomb as secure as you can." So they placed some guards on duty.
