Jesus Is Buried – Matthew 27:57–66; Mark 15:42–47; Luke 23:50–56; John 19:38–42

It was the **day before** the **Sabbath**. **Jesus** had **died** on the **cross**. As **evening** approached, a rich man named **Joseph**, who was a **follower** of Jesus, went to **Pilate**. He asked for Jesus' body. So Pilate gave the **body** to Joseph.
