 [15. Sigh of relief; Animal noises]

 [17. Sigh of relief; Animal noises]

 [18. Howling wind]

 [26. Coo, coo, coo]

 [28. Clap and cheer;  
Animal noises]

 [29. Coo, coo, coo]
