

## Pray About This

Dear Jesus, thank you for being a righteous and just God who hates evil but blesses those who are faithful to you. I confess that I have done things that are wrong and made you sad. Please forgive me. Please help me obey you and walk faithfully with you. In Jesus' name I pray, Amen.

## Do This

Make a rainbow as a reminder of God's promise to Noah!

There are many different ways you can make a rainbow. The 2 important things you need are: sunlight and water.

One easy way to make a rainbow is this: Stand in your garden on a sunny day. Using a garden hose with a fine mist nozzle, spray some water in the direction of your shadow. A pretty rainbow should appear!

Here's another way: On a sunny day, find a table next to a window or a spot on the floor where the sun is shining in. Place a big piece of white paper there. Fill a glass halfway with water and place it on the paper. Slowly lift your glass. A rainbow should appear on your paper. (If you don't see it, move the paper around and try again. Ensure that sun is shining on the glass of water.)
