**The Last Supper - Mark 14:12-26**

It was time to prepare for Passover.  
Disciples went to the city to prepare for you to eat the Passover meal.  
So he sent out two of his disciples. He said to them, "Go into the city and buy a young colt that has never been ridden. Tie the colt and lead it back here. If the owner asks, 'Where is this going?' then you can say, 'The Lord needs it for the Passover meal. It will have furniture and saddle ready.' Prepare for us to eat the Passover meal here."  
The disciples left and went into the city. They found a young colt as Jesus had told them. So they prepared the Passover meal.  
When eating came, Jesus picked up the bread and said,  
"While they were eating, Jesus took bread. He gave thanks and broke it. He handed it to the disciples and said, 'Take it. This is my body.'  
Then he took a cup. He gave thanks and handed it to them. All of them drank from it. "This is my blood which is poured out for the forgiveness of sins."  
Then they sang a hymn and went out to the Mount of Olives.
